Subject: **Holding of the 6th All India DAD Volley Ball Tournament (Men & Women) by PCDA (NC) Jammu from 19th to 23rd December 2016**

Reference: DASCB Circular of even no dated 26.09.2016

In continuation of DASCB letter cited at reference, it has been decided by the Competent Authority that **6th All India DAD Volley Ball Tournament (Men & Women) will be organised by PCDA (NC) Jammu at Jammu under the aegis of DASCB from 19th to 23rd December 2016 (instead of 5th to 8th December 2016)**

2. Further, the tournament will be played amongst the qualified twelve teams in **Men category** as per details below:

- i) Winner team of the 5th AIDAD Volley Ball tournament i.e. **CGDA Office** (Direct entry)
- ii) Present host team of **PCDA (NC) Jammu** (Direct entry)
- iii) Two teams each from five Zones of DASCB viz. Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western and Central to be qualified through Zonal rounds.

3. As regards to **Women category**, only 05 entries have so far been received and it has been decided by the Competent Authority that the teams of following PCDA/CDA will take part directly in the final rounds to be held at Jammu. The participating teams in Women category are: **PCDA (SC) Pune, PCDA (WC) Chandigarh, PCDA (R&D) New Delhi, CDA Chennai and CDA Jabalpur.**

4. It is, therefore decided by the Competent Authority that the nodal offices nominated will conduct the Zonal rounds by 1st week of December and confirm result of Zonal Rounds (Men) by 5th December 2016 to PCDA (NC) Jammu with copy to DASCB so that fixtures can be organised at their end for final round to be played at Jammu. The nodal offices designated and the venue for the five regions in Men's category is as per Annexure 'A' to this letter.

5. For organisation of Zonal rounds, a sum of Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand only) has been approved by the Competent Authority for each organising Controller's office to meet the expenses for holding of Zonal matches. It is requested to forward the complete bank details to DASCBS along with IFSC Code to enable transfer of funds. The expenditure on boarding, lodging and transportation will be borne by the participants from their TA/DA entitlements etc. The organising Controller's office may liaise with outstations teams for making arrangements in this regard.

6. The accounts along with the original vouchers of the financial assistance provided by DASCBS may also be furnished by 12th December 2016 positively for further action at this end.

7. The rules and regulations of 6th AIDAD Volley Ball Tournament (Zonal rounds) will be as per Annexure 'B' to this letter.

Annexure 'B' to HQrs Office letter dated 16.11.2016

Rules and Regulations of 6th AIDAD Volley Ball Tournament (Zonal Rounds)

1. Each PCDA/CDA office can field one team consisting of 9 players. No manager will accompany with the team.
2. The tournament will be played as per rules and regulations approved by Volley Ball Federation of India.
3. All Matches will be played on round robin league basis except for Zone No. 3 for which Double round robin format will be used in view of lesser number of participating teams. The matches should be completed in maximum 02 days.
4. Five points will be awarded for each win. Top two teams from each zone will qualify for final rounds to be held at Jammu. In case of tie between two or more teams after completion of league matches, the average of points scored by each team in all the matches will be taken into consideration.
5. Qualified referees will be provided by the organising controllers and referee's decision will be final. No protests will be entertained in this regard.
6. Organising Controllers will liaise for making lodging and boarding arrangements for outstation teams only, as per the TA/DA entitlements of the players.
7. The teams should exhibit strict discipline and games shall be played with sportsman spirit. The participants during course of the tournament shall be treated as on temporary duty and TA/DA shall be admissible to the participants as per rules.
8. The participants should carry their Identity cards and shall produce the same as and when demanded.
9. All the teams shall play the matches in proper wearing kits to be provided by the concerned Controller.
