**Subject:- Grant of 11% Adhoc increase in the Myanmar Compensatory Allowance and decrease of depression of 6% for officers and 4% for subordinate staff serving in Myanmar.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your UO No.13012(4)/79/AN-XIV/BCA/Myanmar dated 7.01.2009 and 25.05.2009 and this Ministry letter No. F.11(1)/C/2000 dated 10.02.2000 on the above subject and to convey the sanction of the President for grant of 11% increase in Compensatory Allowance at the rate of Bhutan Compensatory Allowance payable to DAD employees serving in Myanmar under Project Sewak w.e.f. 01.04.2005 in accordance with Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport & Highways sanction No. BRDB/03/125/1998/GE-I dated 12.Jan.2007.

2. The slab deduction prescribed in GOI, Ministry of Surface Transport, BRDB letter No. BRDB/03/71/92-GE-I dated 1.12.1999 will continue to be applicable on the rate of Compensatory Allowance (BCA Rate).

3. All other terms and conditions for drawl of Compensatory Allowance including a cut of 22.5% as depression both for officers and subordinates as stipulated in Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport BRDB letter dated 12.06.1989 shall remain unchanged till 30<sup>th</sup> November 1999 and depression of 6% for officers and 4% for subordinates respectively will be effective w.e.f. 1.12.1999 as applicable to the personnel of IMTRAT as sanctioned vide Ministry of Defence letter No. 1(9)/2000/D: Pay/Services) dated 23.02.2006.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Addl.FA(AM) vide Dy. No. 2233/ Addl.FA(AM) dated 29.09.2009.
