Subject: Celebration of Constitution Day on 26.11.2019

Reference is invited towards captioned subject and find enclosed a copy of the D.O letter No. A2J/Events/02/2014, dated 13.11.2019 of Secretary, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment which is self explanatory.

2. 26th November is celebrated every year as Constitution day to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to honor and acknowledge the contribution of the Founding Fathers of the Constitution by reading the Preamble of the Constitution. This year, i.e 2019 marks the 70th year of the adoption of the Constitution. It has been decided to run an awareness Campaign focused on Citizen's Duties including Fundamental Duties as enshrined in the Constitution from 26th November, 2019 to 26th November, 2020.

3. Following activities/functions/events may be undertaken to celebrate the Constitution Day and to run the awareness campaign throughout the year:-

- (i) Reading of the Preamble on 26th November, 2019. A copy of the Preamble in Hindi and English is attached with aforementioned D.O letter. The Preamble in local languages may be used for reading in schools and colleges and other places.
- (ii) To identify one or more Citizens' Duties and make an action-plan to project the duty in its working during the Campaign period.
- (iii) Talks/conferences/seminars; rallies/walks/runs focused on Citizens' Duties during the Campaign period.
- (iv) To do publicity on website through flyers, standees etc. during the Campaign period.

4. The soft copies/versions of IEC material such as brochures, flyers, posters, films, logo etc. useful in the Campaign would be made available on the websites of the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting (MOI&B) and the Department of Justice(DOJ) for downloading and further use. The list of Resource Persons for delivering talks/lectures in schools, colleges and other centers would also be made available on the website of Department of Justice.

5. It is also requested to prepare a month-wise calendar for effective implementation of activities at all levels with the involvement of maximum number of Departments and Organizations under your control. Reports of activities alongwith photographs and video clippings may be uploaded on the website of Department of Justice (www.doj.gov.in) as well as on the website of Ministry of Defence (www.mod.gov.in)

6. Although, the Constitution Day is celebrated every year, this year it has been desired that both visibility and scale of celebration of events as detailed in para 3 above

should be significantly higher and adequate publicity may be given to the events undertaken during the Campaign period.

7. In view of above, it is, therefore, requested that steps may please be initiated urgently to celebrate the Constitution Day and run the awareness Campaign throughout the year from 26th November, 2019 to 26th November, 2020 in a befitting manner. It is also requested that details of events to be organized on 26.11.2019 (Constitution Day) and month-wise calendar of activities to be undertaken may be prepared and shared with D(Welfare) urgently latest by 21.11.2019.

As you may be aware, 26th November is celebrated every year as Constitution day to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India and to honour and acknowledge the contribution of the Founding Fathers of the Constitution. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment had earlier written vide letter dated 13th November, 2015 to all the Ministries/Departments to celebrate 26th November (Constitution Day) every year by a reading of the 'Preamble' to the Constitution in all Institutions/ Government Offices and other establishments throughout the country and to identify activities at the State and lower levels to celebrate the day. This reading of the Preamble of Constitution is to be done on Constitution Day this year too. A copy of the 'Preamble' in Hindi and English is attached. The Preamble in local language may be used for reading in Schools & Colleges and other places.

2. The current year 2019, marks the 70th year of the adoption of the Constitution. It has been decided by the Government to run an awareness campaign focused on Citizens' Duties including Fundamental Duties as enshrined in the Indian Constitution, from 26th November, 2019 to 26th November, 2020. The Campaign will start with functions and events on 26th November, 2019 and will be carried out throughout the year. An Indicative list of activities to be undertaken during the Campaign by your Ministries/Depts. and State/UT Government is attached. Hon'ble Union Law Minister has addressed a letter to Hon'ble Governors and Hon'ble Chief Ministers on this subject on 01.11.2019.

3. THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ¹[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC] and to secure to all its citizens: Preamble.

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ²[unity and integrity of the Nation];

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
