

## **Minutes of the 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Defence Accounts Sports Control Board**

The 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Defence Accounts Sports Control Board was held at 11 am on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2013 at CGDA conference room under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble CGDA Sh. Arunava Dutt.

3. The meeting started with the welcome address by Secretary DASCBC. He briefed the members on the objectives of the convened DASCBC meeting. This was followed by the playing of the DASCBC anthem with video clippings of the recent activities of DASCBC.

4. **Confirmation of the minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the DASCBC.**

The Board confirmed the minutes of the last meeting.

5. **Action taken on the minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the DASCBC.**

The Secretary informed the Board about the action taken on the minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of DASCBC.

**(A) Indoor and outdoor sports facility.**

- As response from the controllers on the issue has been very slow, it was decided to close the issue. It was also decided that the PCDA/CDA/CFA offices may take a decision on their own for small requirements like carom boards, chess boards, Table Tennis Tables etc.

**(B) Introduction of Nodal officers.**

- After detailed deliberations and discussions it was decided by the Board to have a Nodal Office and a Nodal Officer for each region who will look into the promotion of the games and development of sports facilities identified for their region. The Board decided the nodal offices for various games which are as under:

T.T, Carrom, Chess, Badminton	- DASCB Hqr. CGDA, N.Delhi.
Cricket (Men)	- DASCB Hqrs & PCDA, N.Delhi.
Cricket (Women)	- PCDA (SC) Pune.
Hockey (Men/Women)	- PCDA (WC) Chandigarh.
Basketball (Men)	- PCA (Fys) Kolkata.
Basketball (Women)	- CDA, Chennai
Volleyball (Men)	- PCDA (P) Allahabad
Volleyball (Women)	- CDA, Chennai

- Separate letters will also be issued to the concerned PCDA/CDA/PCA offices for development of sports facilities at their stations.

7. After detailed discussions, it was decided by the board that the sports persons recruited under sports quota will participate in competitions at District/ State and National levels as DASCB teams. **Sports quota recruits will be allowed to go for practice sessions three days in a week for 2 hrs from 4 pm to 6 pm.**

8. DASCB teams will be provided with sports uniforms with DASCB logo once in a year if they participate in the open tournaments at District/State & National level on behalf of DASCB. The color of the uniform shall be blue/grey combination for practice and as per sports requirement for the game. DASCB teams will wear the same uniforms during all the tournaments. It has also been decided by the board that other facilities like playing equipments etc will be provided based on the performance of the teams on case to case basis. Regional members and other PCDA/CDA/CFA may inform the board about the sporting events of state/national level being organized in their particular region so that DASCB teams may be sponsored for participating in those events.

**9. Funding of All India DAD Tournaments.**

After detailed deliberations and discussions, it has been decided by the board that All India DAD Tournaments during the financial year 2013-2014 will be organized with a provision that 90% of the sanctioned budget will be met by DASCB, and the rest 10% of budget will be arranged by the organizing Controllers. This funding pattern (90:10) is being introduced on experimental basis in place of existing 80:20 ratios.

**10. Tentative Sports calendar for the year 2013-14.**

After detailed discussions, it was decided by the Board to organize following games in the financial year 2013-14.
