Subject:- Procurement of Vehicles under the Delgated Financial Powers.

Reference:- DG FP letter No. 88896/Gen/GS/FP-2 dated 31st October 2012.

The matter of ban on procurement of vehicles has been examined in this Division and it is clarified that the supply of DGOF vehicles is qualitatively different from procurement ex-trade. While the latter is covered under the ban, the former is not, being in the nature of internal production from a dedicated in-house Government facility.

2. It is therefore, advised that necessary indents may be placed on DGOF for supply of vehicles and the expenditure booked without further delay.
