Recommendation No. 4(i): /Departments Ministries All Governments of States / UTs and their subordinate/attached offices/Autonomous Organizations, may ensure that their proposed calendar of activities, compliance reproduction of dustice's website at the early Recommendation No. 4(ii): compliance reports photos are updated on the Department of Justice's website at the earliest.

All Departments/Wings in MoD have already been apprised of the direction vide MoD I.D Note No. 11011/09/D(Welfare)/2019 dated 25.11.2019 with the request to comply with the same strictly. However, the recommendation is reiterated.
