In the light of recommendations of Committee of Secretaries set up by the government to consider various issues on pension of Armed Forces pensioners, the President is pleased to decide that the benefit of adding years of qualifying service for the purpose of computing Gratuity in respect of Personnel Below Officer Rank (PBOR) retiring or dying in harness on or after 1.1.2006, shall be restored with effect from 1.1.2006. Pension Sanctioning Authorities shall suomoto issue revised corrigendum PPOs notifying the Gratuity accrued in terms of these orders.
