Holding of the 11th All India DAD Cricket Tournament (Men & Women) at Lucknow in the month of October - 2023

It has been decided by the Competent Authority that 11th All India DAD Cricket Tournament (Men & Women) will be organised by IFA(CC), Lucknow under the aegis of DASCB from 04.10.2023 to 08.10.2023 (and 09.10.2023 as reserve day for final match in case of any eventuality) at Lucknow.

- 2. Further, as decided by the competent authority the tournament will be played amongst the qualified 08 teams in Men Category as per details below:

 Men Category:
 - i.) Winner team of the 10th AIDAD Cricket tournament i.e CDA, Jabalpur (Direct entry)
 - ii) Host Team, i.e. IFA(CC)/PCDA(CC), Lucknow (Direct entry)
 - iii) One team consisting of only IDAS officers from all over India (Direct entry)
 - iv) One team each from five Zones of DASCB viz. Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western and Central.
- 3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Competent Authority that the addressee Pr.Controllers/Controller offices will conduct the Zonal round latest by 24th September, 2023 and confirm the participation of winners teams of Zonal Round (Men) latest by 27th September, 2023 to the organisers of final round i.e. IFA(CC), Lucknow for further action at their end under intimation to this HQrs office. A list of offices in the jurisdiction of each Zone is enclosed as Annexure 'A' to this letter.
- 4. Further, it is added that all the correspondence with the respective Pr. Controllers/ Controllers of their zone/region regarding holding up of the zonal rounds may be made at your end under intimation to this HQrs office.
- 5. Competent Authority has also approved the budget of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand only) for each organizing PCDA/CDA to organize the zonal

tournament. It is, therefore, requested to forward the Bank details to DASCB for releasing the sanctioned amount.

6. Rules and Regulation for conducting zonal tournament are enclosed where with as Annexure 'B'.

7. Instructions for the Women tournament will be issued separately.

- 1. All the matches of the tournament will be played in T-20 format as per rules of BCCI.
- 2. The zonal tournament would be conducted on League cum knock out basis by dividing the participating teams in groups, to be decided by the organizing controller. All the teams in a group to play with each other and top two teams from each group will qualify for intra-zonal finals.
- 3. Winner of Zonal finals will proceed to play the main tournament from particular Zone.
- 4. Each team can send maximum of 14 players.
- 5. No manager/coach is allowed to accompany the team.
- 6. The decision of the Umpire nominated by the Nodal Office will be final.
- 7. Men tournament will be played with white ball/colored dress.
