The National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH), an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Home Affairs, was established in 1992. The Foundation provides financial assistance to the children who become destitutes/orphans in communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence. The assistance is meant for their care, education and training for effective rehabilitation. So far 12402 such children have been assisted under this scheme. The number of children on the live register of the scheme is 7246.

- 2. The Foundation was set up with a modest corpus which is not enough to continue and expand its activities to achieve the goal. It has consequently been striving to raise funds from various partners / donors on voluntary basis.
- The 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' is observed every year 3. from 19th to 25th November. The last working day of the week is observed as 'Flag Day' of the Foundation. Accordingly, this year, the Foundation will observe the 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' from 19th November to 25th November, 2018 and 22nd November will be observed as 'Flag Day'. It would be appropriate, if the campaign week is observed befittingly in your Ministry/Department during the aforesaid period by organizing cultural programmes, seminars, painting competitions etc. to effectively promote the values of communal harmony and National integration. The Foundation has separately dispatched brochures, posters, wrappers, pamphlets, flag stickers and other publicity material for observing 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week and Flag Day'. Guidelines/steps to be taken during the aforesaid campaign week are annexed.

- 4. The 'Communal Harmony Campaign Week' is utilized also to raise funds to support activities of the Foundation. With a view to encouraging voluntary contributions, provisions of Rule 12 of the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964 have been relaxed and the Central Government servants are allowed to participate in collection of funds for this purpose on voluntary basis. Donation made to the Foundation is 100% exempted from Income Tax under Section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961. This may be brought to the notice of all officers/staff working under your Ministry/Department to encourage them to contribute generously towards this noble cause.
- 5. I look forward to your whole hearted cooperation and support for the cause of promotion of communal harmony and National integration to raise adequate funds for the Foundation to help it pursue its objective.

Steps to be taken for observing the Communal Harmony Campaign and the Flag Day

The following steps are required to be taken for observance of the Communal Harmony Campaign by the office:

- (i) To do intensive campaigning and provide wide publicity for sensitizing officers and staff and public as a whole about the need for fostering communal harmony, National integration and fraternity, through cultural programmes, debates, seminars, workshops, essay competitions, painting competitions etc.
- (ii) To make arrangements for circulation of fund collection boxes wooden, plastic or metallic boxes may be improvised with suitable openings to insert the donation.
- (iii) To select volunteers from amongst staff to station themselves at the entrance and other vantage points and go around the office buildings on the Flag Day for distribution of flag stickers and collection of voluntary donation.
- (iv) To make suitable arrangements for proper security of collection boxes, opening them, counting the amount so collected and sending to NFCH.
- (v) Remittance of funds so collected should be made through Demand Drafts/cheque to the Secretary, National Foundation for Communal Harmony, 9th floor, 'C' Wing, Lok Nayak Bhawan, Khan Market, New Delhi-110003.
- (vi) Bank Draft should be sent through Registered/Speed/Ordinary Post and not by courier. Alternatively donation can also be made by direct bank transfer from anywhere in India, utilizing the following information:
