Sir,

I am directed to state that to fill up one post of Member, Competition Appellate Tribunal through direct recruitment, applications are invited from eligible Indian nationals.

- 2. The Competition Act, 2002 provides that the Member of the CAT shall be a person of ability, integrity and standing having special knowledge of, and professional experience of <u>not less than twenty five years in</u>, competition matters including competition law and policy, international trade, economics, business, commerce, law, finance, accountancy, management, industry, public affairs, administration or in any other matter which in the opinion of the Central Government, may be useful to the Appellate Tribunal.
- 3. Keeping in view the role and importance of CAT as an adjudicator, it is desirable that the applications from the persons with high integrity, eminence and reputation with requisite experience are forwarded for consideration.
- 4. The terms and conditions of the service of the Members of CAT are regulated by the Competition Appellate Tribunal (Salaries and Allowances and other terms and conditions of service of the Chairperson and other Members) Rules, 2009, as amended from time to time. The Members shall hold office for a term of five years and shall be eligible for reappointment. However, no Member of the Appellate Tribunal shall hold office as such after he has attained the age of sixty-five years. Member shall be paid a salary of eighty thousand rupees (fixed) per mensem and admissible allowances.

- 5. Applications in respect of eligible officers in the Central Government or in the State Government, who are interested and can be spared in the event of selection may be forwarded duly verified/ countersigned by the Head of Departments (where applicable) along with the following documents:
 - (i) Up-to-date and complete Confidential Report (CR) dossiers in original/attested photocopies of last 5 years Annual Confidential Reports (ACR) of the candidate.
 - (ii) Integrity Certificate
 - (iii) Vigilance Clearance including certification that no disciplinary proceedings or criminal proceedings are either pending or contemplated against the officer concerned.
 - (iv) List of major/minor penalties, if any, imposed on the candidates during the last ten years/ No penalty certificate.
