Inspite of clear instructions on the subject circulated vide letters of even no. dated 28-12-98, 19 Jul 2005 and 4 Sep 2008, repeated complaints are being received in HQrs office that the medical claims are shuttling between the Controllers office and PAOs, which often delays the payment and lead to unnecessary complaints to higher authorities. Controllers' offices are advising Units to forward claims to other Controllers without referring to the rule position which clearly prescribes which office is to process OPD/indoor treatment claims.

2. It is, reiterated that Medical claims in respect of service personnel for treatment in Civil/Private hospitals may be dealt with in accordance with rules as enclosed. These instructions may be got noted by all concerned and confirmation sent to HQrs office.
