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Para 8.11 of Appendix D to Chapter I (Page 50)

"In exceptional cases, DOMW may recommend change in offset partner or offset component on being convinced that the change is necessary to enable the vendor to fulfil offset obligations. Any change in IOP/offset component of a Tier-I sub-vendor will have to be forwarded to DOMW through the main/prime vendor. The overall value offset obligations shall, however, remain unchanged. Any change in the IOP shall be approved by Secretary (Defence Production). Any change in the offset component will require approval of the Raksha Mantri based on the recommendations of the Defence Procurement Board (DPE)."

"DOMW may recommend change in offset partner or offset component on being convinced that the change is necessary to enable the vendor to fulfil offset obligations. Any change in IOP/offset component of a Tier-1 subvendor will have to be forwarded to DOMW through the main/prime vendor. The overall value of offset obligations shall, however, remain unchanged. Any change in the IOP and offset component shall be approved by the Secretary (Defence Production)."

- 2. These amendments shall come into effect immediately and shall also be applicable to all offset contracts and ongoing procurement cases, irrespective of the applicable DPP.
- 3. All concerned authorities may kindly note for information and compliance.
